**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

Lawn should be mowed first. Apply fertilizer evenly with spreader. During fertilizer application, the leaves should be dry and soil moist. Water fertilizer thoroughly into the soil with a medium spray from a hand held nozzle.

**Existing Lawns:** Apply 15 pounds per 2000 sq. ft. every 10 to 12 weeks. First application should be made in March to break the dormancy of Bermuda and St. Augustine grasses.

**Developing New Lawns:** Apply 15 pounds per 2000 sq. ft. every 6 weeks (six times a year). First application should be made in March to initiate new growth.

**Preparing New Lawns:** After soil has been prepared and leveled, broadcast 1 pound per 100 sq. ft. (10' x 10') evenly onto surface. Sow seed and cover with lawn spread. Water lawn with fine mist until top 4 inches of soil is saturated. Do not let water run off. Surface should be kept moist until grass begins to grow.
